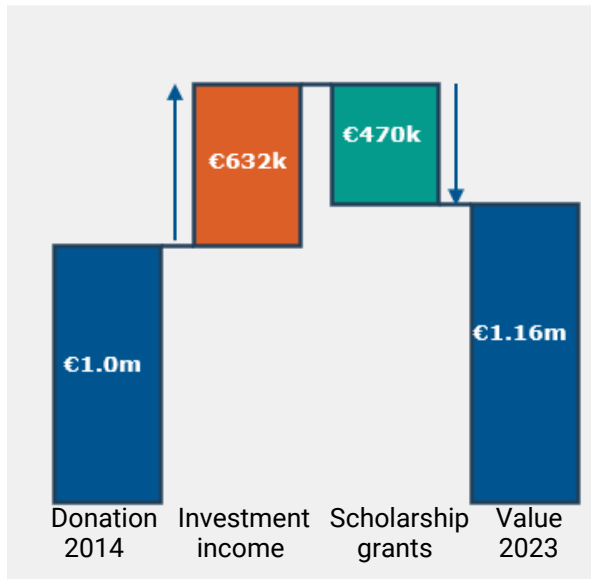

# IMPACT OF €1M DONATION

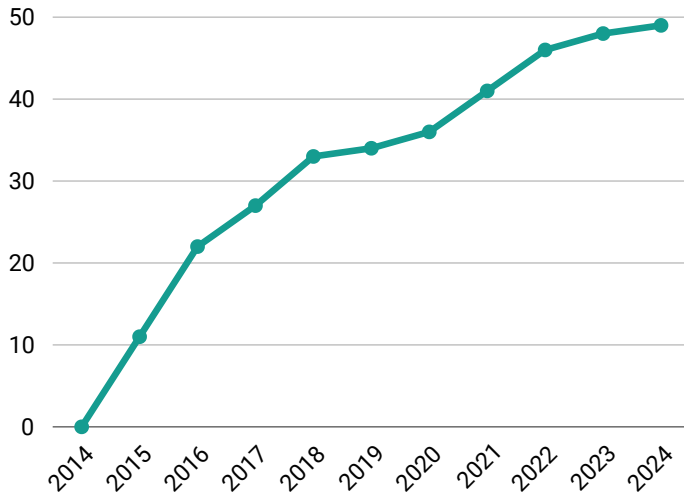
Illustration of €1m donation received in 2014 and the number of students funded over those years and the value of that endowment in August 2023.



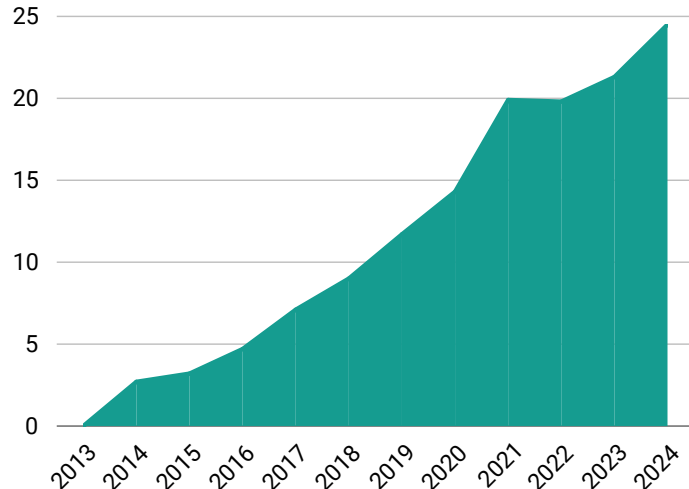
# FINANCIAL HIGHLIGHTS
